**The following criteria must be met in order for a vehicle to be considered abandoned:**

- The vehicle is in Unincorporated Kitsap County
- The vehicle is on the public right-of-way
- The vehicle is on a county maintained road
- The vehicle is NOT on a state highway, city street, or private road.
- The vehicle has NOT been moved for 24 hours
